- 3. Fire alarms and signs need to be placed and installed.
- 4. The original back altar is to be incorporated into the current chapel. (in progress)
- 5. DONE Repository
- 6. Church floors need to be professionally polished in order to extend their life span.
- 7. Repair of recently discovered cracks in the front of the church wall.
- 8. Presbytery house dining room to have a built extension outwards into a multi-use meeting room for parish use, as we don't have a parish hall.
- 9. Ashes garden of remembrance needs to be revitalised and beautified.
- 10. The current leftover loan debt from Fr Pat Salmon's (RIP) chapel build is at £15.000, which is the reason that we are not allowed to get any further funding for any new works.
